Easter Memorials

The Liturgy Committee would like to thank parishioners for helping create seasonal environments throughout the year. As we enter the Lenten and Easter Seasons, we often think of loved ones who have made a lasting impression in our hearts. There are many ways to remember those we love. One way is through seasonal memorials. If you would like to remember a loved one through an Easter Memorial, you will have the opportunity to do so on **the weekends of February 25/26, March 4/5, March 11/12, and March 18/19**. You have three options for submitting a memorial/honorarium.

1. For those attending mass in person, Memorial cards for flowers, palms, and general Easter environment will be available before and after mass on the above weekends. Please plan in advance. Here are your options:
 - * (Preferred) **Fill memorial card out at church and provide payment at that time.**
 - * Fill out the card at church and then submit your payment at a later mass or to the office. Please make sure you specify your payment is for your Easter memorial.
2. For those who are participating in mass remotely:
 - * you can stop by the church office to fill out your memorial/honorarium card and submit your payment at that time.
 - * call the parish office 929-7490, or Mary Kay McCarthy (929-4070), to fill out your card and then you can mail or drop off your payment at the parish office. Please make sure you specify your payment is for your Easter memorial.

Approximate Prices per plant: Begonias & Mums \$20 each, Easter Lily \$40, Hydrangea \$40, and Palm plants \$40. We have not received the plant prices for 2023 so these prices may be different on the day you submit your memorial. When you sponsor a plant, you will have the option to keep the plant. We only ask that you pick up your plant within a day or two of being contacted by a Liturgy Committee member. We will be replacing flowers throughout the Easter Season as needed. All flowers can be planted in a pot for outside use and may flower again later in the growing season. Easter lilies and Hydrangeas can be planted in the ground. Thank you again for your generosity. We pray you have a reflective and blessed Lenten and Easter Season.
